

STRATEGIC CAREER PLANNING COURSE - CFAN 4201

Open to sophomores, juniors, seniors and graduate students
1 Credit; Open to students in any major

Description: Want to get ahead of the competition when searching for jobs and internships? This 1 credit course is ideal for undergraduate and graduate students in any major seeking internships and/or full time work. It is recommended that you have 45+ credits before registering for this course. This course covers topics that will prepare you for your job/internship search including skills assessment, resume writing, interviewing, job searching and salary negotiation.

Class Time: 65% lecture, 10% discussion, 25% Class Activities

Work Load: 5-15 pages of reading per week, 5-6 pages of writing per semester, 0 exam(s), 1 paper(s), portfolio & resume required

Grade: 25% written report(s)/paper(s), 50% special project(s), 10% class participation, 15% inventories & class activities
